Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) requires that any staff member who uses an N95 respirator be medically cleared via Respirator Medical Clearance (RMC) and fittested each year. Those identified must undergo fit testing before first use and annually as part of the **MGB Respiratory Protection Program (RPP)** to meet OSHA compliance requirements. This program is designed for the safety and well-being of our workforce.
